Admission Process: Upon acceptance you will be sent a package of documents and additional requirements that will include:

1. Proof of a recent tetanus shot and a negative tuberculosis test
2. Copy of your high school transcripts or GED
3. A photograph of yourself
4. Questionnaire
5. Student fact sheet
6. Student policies
7. Final payment is due three weeks prior to the first day of the class.

Minimum Requirements for Admission

- Working with exotic animals requires some moderate lifting and other physical work, students should be able to lift 50 lbs.
- Applicants must be healthy and free from any physical handicaps which could affect their ability to safely and satisfactorily perform the responsibilities required. Any medical conditions or medications must be fully disclosed.
- Minimum age is 18 years.

Hollywood Animals, as HA, agrees to lease to the undersigned, HA animal(s), trainers and/or property for the rates listed above for photography and educational purposes.

Refund Policy

Refund before the class begins: A full refund of all money paid if the applicant is not accepted by the School. A full refund of all money paid if the applicant withdraws not later than the third business day after registering. After three business days, the school will retain the initial deposit of \$600.00 and an established registration fee which shall not exceed one hundred dollars and cost of supplies. However the student can apply the funds to the following class." Registration fee" refers to any fee, however named, covering those expenses incurred by an institution in processing student applications and establishing a student records system and supplies.

Refund after starting the courses: If the student withdraws after the first class, the student will be refunded their money based on the percentages below minus the deposit (\$600.00) and registration fees and cost of supplies and books (\$100.00). Students who have attended 1 day of the course will receive 50% of the tuition. Students who have attended 2 days of the course will receive 10% of the tuition. Students who have attended 2 or more of the course will receive 0%

To receive a refund, students must send the school a formal letter of withdrawal requesting a refund. All refunds will be mailed within 30 days of receipt of a written request. Terms of refund are subject to change until the first day of the course.

Attendance

Students are expected to attend and be punctual for all scheduled classes. Students not attending more than 2 scheduled classes will be withdrawn from the course. A student late to class with out contacting the office will be counted as tardy. (Three tardies = one absence).

- Hollywood Animals, as HA, agrees to lease to the undersigned, HA animal(s), trainers and/or property for the rates listed above for photography and educational purposes.
- Lodging and meals are not included in the course tuition. Students must arrange their own accommodations individually. We provide daily student pickup at the two local motels (Travelodge and Country Inn). Both are about 15 minutes driving time from our ranch. The school has a refrigerator and microwave that students can use, however, it is the students' responsibility to bring lunch and drinks to class each day.
- Demands will include
 1. Reading, exams, quizzes, it is recommended that students receive their books in advance.
 2. Minimum of 8 hr and maximum of 11 hrs a day
 3. Because of the potential for sever injury to both people and animals at HA; it is particularly important students strictly adhere to the safety regulations. You will be working very closely with other people and around potentially dangerous animals therefore safety is our primary concern. You will be given a list of rules and ranch policies, which you will be expected to strictly adhere to at all times. Due to the clear and present danger with and around the animals, Hollywood Animals reserves the right to terminate any student (without a written or verbal notice) for any reason including but not limited to, the following:
 - Inappropriate behavior towards any animal.
 - Inappropriate behavior towards any instructor or school representative.
 - Lack of aptitude and/or progress
 - Non attendance and habitual tardiness
 - Any undisclosed medical or physical condition
 - Disruptive or unacceptable conduct
 - Violation of the school / ranch rules and/or policies
 - Under these circumstances, the tuition is non-refundable.
